User's Guides to search public information on PRTR-Spain










What information can you consult here?

The facility inventory shows the total number of industrial facilities included in PRTR-España. It has a search engine that allows the user to carry out searches according to the different criteria.



(1) <u>Free text</u>. Allows the user to search by name of the facilities (the one registered by the company), PRTR code and name of its parent company.

If the user wants to search installations by geographical region, the search engine provides fields to filter complexes by **Autonomous Regions** and by **River Basin Districts** (it allows multiselection).

In addition, this search engine allows the user filtering the facilities by other parameters:

- (2) <u>Industrial Activities</u>. It allows filtering facilities according to the industrial activities included in the PRTR-España Register described in Annex 1 of Royal Decree 508/2007 and its subsequent amendment in Annex 5 of Royal Decree 815/2013.
- (3) <u>Inventory of industrial Establishments (PRTR-DEI).</u> It allows filtering facilities depending on the regulations that affect them.





- All: refers to all industrial facilities included in the PRTR-Spain Register, according to Annex 1 of Royal Decree 508/2007 as amended by Annex 5 of Royal Decree 815/2013.
- PRTR facilities refers to all facilities reporting to PRTR-Europe (EPRTR), facilities within the scope of application of the European Union's E-PRTR Regulation (Annex 1 of Regulation 166/2006).
- IED permit installations: those facilities that have AAI and are DEI activity, i.e. those facilities within the framework of Annex I of the Royal Legislative Decree 1/2016 that transposes the European Union's Industrial Emissions Directive 2010/75/EU (DEI).
- Plants: large combustion plants, incineration, and co-incineration plants in accordance with Royal Legislative Decree 1/2016, Royal Decree 815/2013 and Directive 2010/75/EU.

It should be noted that the scope of the PRTR Register in Spain is more extensive than the European one. At state level, all activities that are DEI (IPPC) are also PRTR. However, there are activities in PRTR that are not DEI (IPPC). At the European level, the scope of the DEI and the E-PRTR are different. Although all of them now report to the EU-Registry.

- (4) <u>Status</u>. Allows the user to filter by the real-time status.
 - o All
 - Active facilities: those facilities whose industrial activity is in operation. Included in this category are facilities that are in partial or temporary cessation of activity.
 - Non-active facilities: this category includes only those facilities that are closed, decommissioned or dismantled, i.e. that are in total cessation of activity.

As a result, the user will get a list of industrial facilities that meet the selected requirements.

Clicking on the name of a facility takes you to its file, which shows the administrative data based on the EU-Registry scheme with its generated emissions and waste transfer data. The information corresponding to the consumption tab is voluntary, so the facility has the option to make it public or not. In the IED permit (*Autorización Ambiental Integrada, AAI*) section, the information related to this authorization of the installation can be found, if applicable.
